
### **AGRICULTURE OVERVIEW**

#### Key Agricultural and Allied Sector Exports from India (US\$ Bn)




India's agricultural exports have grown by 19.92% during 2021-22 to touch \$50.21 Bn.

#### Horticulture:

- India exports Fruits worth 750.7 USD Millions and Vegetables worth 767.01 USD Millions
- Indian horticulture held a market value of USD 190.84
  Million in 2021 and is estimated to reach USD 271.25
  Million by the year 2030 with a CAGR of 4.19%.

- Floriculture exports account for 103.47 USD Millions in 2021–22.

#### Agrochemicals:

- Indian agrochemical market size reached a value of 6
   USD Billions in 2022 and will reach 9.82 USD Billions in
   2028 with an expected CAGR of 8.6%.
- India is the world's **4th largest producer** of agrochemicals.





The application of agricultural equipment over manual labor for farming activities is known as farm mechanization




More than 50% of the AgriMachinery products are produced in Maharashtra, Gujarat, Punjab and Haryana

### **MARKET DRIVERS**


- Rise in demand in the agricultural segment is driving growth of agrochemicals in India
- Decreasing arable land in India (15-20% crop output is lost due to by pests, weeds and diseases)
- Government. has set Agricultural export policy and agri exports to USD\$ 60 bn by 2022 which will improve agrochemical's export potential
- Government is going to increase fertilizer subsidy leading to more demand from farmer's
- The government plans to introduce production-linked incentive (PLI) scheme to promote domestic manufacturing of agrochemicals, especially technicals
