About this form

Between 8 April and 31 May 2024, the Climate Change Commission is consulting on three pieces of advice we are currently developing, all related to Aotearoa New Zealand's emissions reduction targets and emissions budgets. These are:

- Advice on the fourth emissions budget period (2036–2040), and whether emissions budgets one, two and three should be revised¹
- Review of Aotearoa New Zealand's 2050 emissions reduction target²
- Review on whether emissions from international aviation and shipping should be included in the 2050 target³
